

Cleaning of Safe Ensuite Sanitaryware

Preferably the product should be cleaned daily, with warm soapy water and thoroughly rinsed with cold water. If desired the product can be dried with a soft cloth.

The gel coat has a high gloss surface abrasive cleaners and scouring powders should be avoided as long term these will scratch and damage the gel coat.

Non abrasive cleaning agents can be used however we recommend testing the product on a small inconspicuous area to ensure compatibility checking there is no deterioration in the surface quality. The cleaning product should be used as per the manufactures instructions.

If bleach is used to sanitise the product it is important that the bleach is removed by thorough rinsing with copious amounts of water or in the case of a WC it should be flushed immediately after sanitizing, bleach should not left in contact with the product for a long period.

Care should be taken to avoid contact with the following chemicals as they can damage the gel coat: paint strippers, strong disinfectants, alcohol, after shave, perfumes, nail varnishes and their removers.
